





Figure 1. Output Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 4. Gate Charge




Figure 5. On-Resistance vs Gate to Source Voltage




Figure 6. Normalized On-Resistance




Figure 7. RDS(on) VS Drain Current




Figure 8. Forward characteristics of reverse diode




Figure 9. Normalized breakdown voltage




Figure 10. Normalized Threshold voltage




Figure 11. Current dissipation




Figure 12. Power dissipation




Figure 13. Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance




Figure 14. Safe Operation Area





Figure A. Unclamped Inductive Switching (UIS) Test Circuit &amp; Waveform



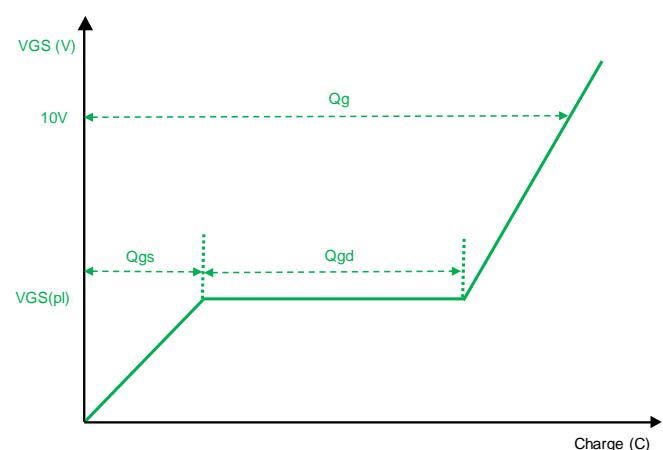
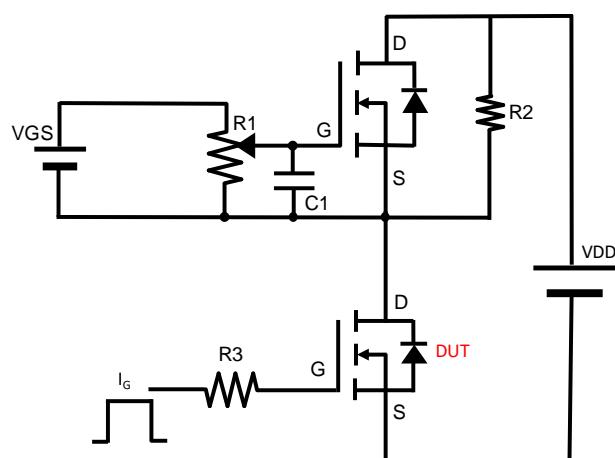


Figure B. Gate Charge Test Circuit &amp; Waveform

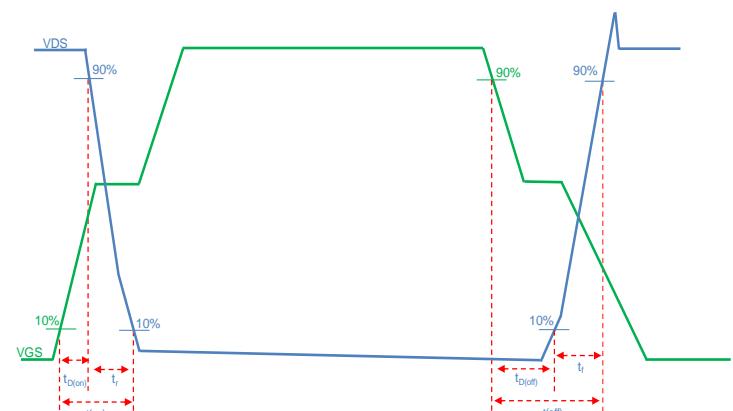
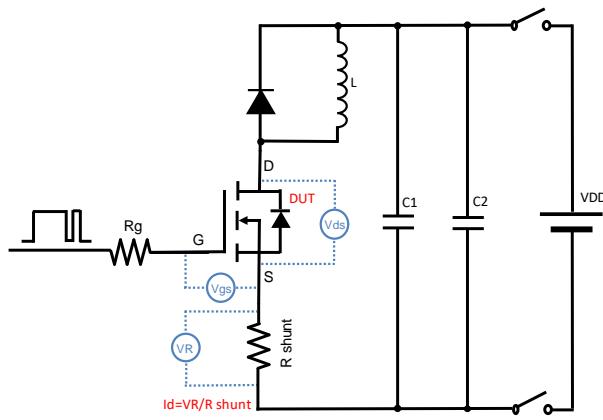


Figure C. Resistive Switching Test Circuit &amp; Waveform

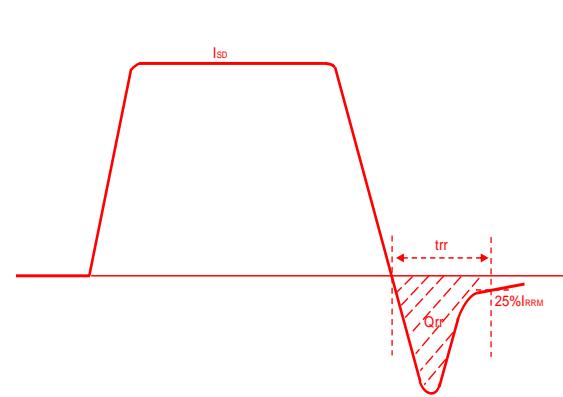
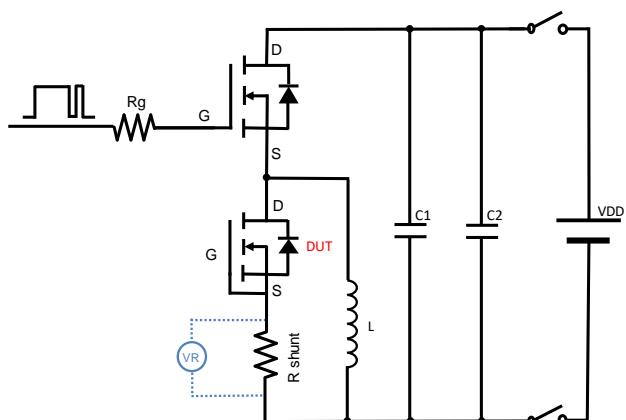






Figure D. Diode Recovery Test Circuit &amp; Waveform
